IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DOG OWNERS

(1) Definition of a PENSIONER for concessional licensing is as follows:

- ☐ Aged Pension ☐ Disability Pension ☐ Commonwealth Health Care Card

(2) To licence a dog under sterilised concessional rates an owner or agent should either have a veterinarian's certificate or be prepared to sign a statutory declaration to the effect.

(3) Refunds for Sterilisation

An owner who has paid the registration fee for an unsterilized dog and subsequently has his dog sterilised in the registration period may claim a refund of the difference of that period. This amendment has been promoted by various local governments and the public and is a further incentive for dog owners to sterilise their dogs as soon as possible.

(4) Refunds for Pensioners

Where a person has paid a three year registration licence and subsequently becomes a pensioner, the person may claim a 50% refund for each whole year of the unexpired period of the licence.

(5) It is important to note that there will be NO REFUNDS for the cancellation of a dog registration (deceased dog).
